The Audi e-tron GT quattro is an all-electric all-wheel drive sedan. It came out in 2021. Brand new, the car starts around \$106,500.

The Audi e-tron GT quattro has a 93.4 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 253 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 33.6 kWh per 100 miles (or 336 Wh/mile) — ranked №228 out of 586 electric vehicles.
