The Citroen C-Zero is an all-electric rear-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2016. Citroën stopped making the Citroen C-Zero in 2020. The car is not available on the US market.

The Citroen C-Zero has a 16 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 61 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 23.8 kWh per 100 miles (or 238 Wh/mile) — ranked №583 out of 586 electric vehicles.
