



Audi e-tron S (Europe)

The Audi e-tron S is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2020. Audi stopped making the S in 2022 and replaced it with the Audi SQ8 e-tron. You can still find Audi e-tron S on the used car market, with prices starting around \$44,999.

The Audi e-tron S has a 95 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 199 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 43.5 kWh per 100 miles (or 435 Wh/mile) — ranked №396 out of 586 electric vehicles.
