The Audi Q8 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2022 replacing the older Audi e-tron Sportback 50 quattro. The car is not available on the US market.

The Audi Q8 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro has a 95 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 249 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 35.7 kWh per 100 miles (or 357 Wh/mile) — ranked №236 out of 586 electric vehicles.
