



Audi Q4 e-tron 55 quattro (Europe)

The Audi Q4 e-tron 55 quattro is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2023 replacing the older Audi Q4 e-tron 50 quattro. Brand new, the car starts around \$55,200.

The Audi Q4 e-tron 55 quattro has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 262 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 29.4 kWh per 100 miles (or 294 Wh/mile) — ranked N°203 out of 586 electric vehicles.
