The Opel Astra-e Sports Tourer is an all-electric front-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2023. The car is not available on the US market.

The Opel Astra-e Sports Tourer has a 54 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 218 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 23.3 kWh per 100 miles (or 233 Wh/mile) — ranked №347 out of 586 electric vehicles.
