



Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro (USA)

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. Audi stopped making the 50 quattro in 2024 and replaced it with the Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 55 quattro. You can still find Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro on the used car market, with prices starting around \$43,375.

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 248 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 30.9 kWh per 100 miles (or 309 Wh/mile) — ranked №241 out of 586 electric vehicles.
