



## Tesla Model S 60 (2016) (Europe)

The Tesla Model S 60 (2016) is an all-electric rear-wheel drive liftback. It came out in 2016 replacing the older Tesla Model S 60 (2015). Tesla stopped making the 60 (2016) in 2017 and replaced it with the Tesla Model S 75D. You can still find Tesla Model S 60 (2016) on the used car market, with prices starting around \$21,000.

The Tesla Model S 60 (2016) has a 75 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 198 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 31.3 kWh per 100 miles (or 313 Wh/mile) — ranked N°398 out of 586 electric vehicles.
