



Kia Soul EV Long Range (2020) (USA)

The Kia Soul EV 64 kWh is an all-electric front-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2022 replacing the older Kia Niro EV 39 kWh. The car is not available on the US market.

The Kia Soul EV 64 kWh has a 67.5 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 239 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 26.8 kWh per 100 miles (or 268 Wh/mile) — ranked N°285 out of 586 electric vehicles.
