



BMW i3 BEV 60 Ah (USA)

The BMW i3 BEV 60 Ah is an all-electric rear-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2013. BMW stopped making the BEV 60 Ah in 2017 and replaced it with the BMW i3 BEV 94 Ah. You can still find BMW i3 BEV 60 Ah on the used car market, with prices starting around \$20,685.

The BMW i3 BEV 60 Ah has a 21.6 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 85 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 22.1 kWh per 100 miles (or 221 Wh/mile) — ranked №556 out of 586 electric vehicles.
