



## Tesla Model S 85 (USA)

The Tesla Model S 85 is an all-electric rear-wheel drive liftback. It came out in 2012. Tesla stopped making the 85 in 2016 and replaced it with the Tesla Model S 75. You can still find Tesla Model S 85 on the used car market, with prices starting around \$17,995.

The Tesla Model S 85 has a 85 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 249 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 32.4 kWh per 100 miles (or 324 Wh/mile) — ranked №236 out of 586 electric vehicles.
